#### START: 8AM - PARKING LOT NEAR PRESIDIO YACHT CLUB

Navigation address: 557 McReynolds Road, Sausalito

## **LEG 1: START TO MUIR BEACH** (11.2 miles)

Note: We will be going through the towns of Sausalito and Mill Valley. There will be lots of traffic lights and stop signs. There is a 100% chance that the group will be broken up. Everyone will be able to get together once again as we hit Shoreline Highway and drop into Muir Beach.

**Head North** onto **East Road** and straight on **South Street**, follow the waterfront to **Bridgeway** through the town of Sausalito. In the middle of Sausalito, there is a public restroom on the waterside. (4.4 miles)

Use the right 2 lanes to merge onto **US-101** on ramp

Take the very 1st exit (0.2 mile) CA-1 Mill Valley/Stinson Beach

Go over Coyote Creek and take a hard left to stay on Shoreline Hwy (1.0 mile)

**Follow Shoreline Hwy**, stay straight, follow signs to Stinson Beach (5.7 miles) See picture below for possible confusing intersection.



Do **NOT** turn right at Panoramic Hwy, keep left towards Stinson Beach!

# LEG 2: UP PANORAMIC HWY, OVER RIDGECREST TO POINT REYES STATION (30.4 miles)

**Head North** on **CA-1** to the town of Stinson Beach (5.6 miles)

**Right Turn** onto **Panoramic Hwy** (3.6 miles)

Sharp Left Turn onto Pantoll Road (1.4 miles)



# At the top of Pantoll Road, turn **Left** onto **Ridgecrest Blvd** (3.8 miles)

These roads are used in many car commercials. There are a few spots to pull over and check out the view. This is an amazing road to enjoy!

At the T, take a **Left** onto **Fairfax-Bolinas Road** (4.4 m)

**Right Turn** onto **CA-1**, follow into Point Reyes Station. (11.5 miles)

Continue straight onto **Mesa Road** (0.1 miles).

There is a nice, clean public restroom on the right hand side, it's a good place to stop. Our official stop will be at Rancho Nicasio, 10 miles down the road. There are only Porta-Potties available in Nicasio.



# LEG 3: OLD ST. MARY'S CHURCH, NICASIO (10.0 miles)

Head North on Mesa Road (500 feet)

**Right Turn** on **CA-1** (0.4 miles)

**Right Turn** at the T to **Pt. Reyes - Petaluma Road** (3.1 miles)

**Left Turn** after the bridge to stay on **Pt. Reyes - Petaluma Road** (3.0 miles)

**Right Turn** at Nicasio Valley Road (3.3 miles)

**Left Turn at Rancho Nicasio** and park along the street next to the church. (Rest stop and photo opportunity)



# **LEG 4: NICASIO TO THE RACERS GROUP** (21.7 miles)

Reverse our route, heading **North** on **Nicasio Valley Road** (3.4 miles)

Right Turn onto Pt. Reyes - Petaluma Road (4.3 miles)

**Left Turn** onto **Hicks Valley Road** (2.7 miles)

**Right Turn** at the T onto **Wilson Hill Road** (2.6 miles)

Continue Straight onto Chileno Valley Road (3.8 miles)

**Right Turn** at the T onto **Western Ave** (1.7 miles)

Right Turn onto Howard Road, turns into 6th St (0.3 miles)

**Left Turn** onto **D St,** over the drawbridge (0.5 miles)

**Right Turn** onto **Lakeville St** (1.9 miles)

**Right Turn** onto **South McDowell Blvd** (0.4 miles)
