## **TWO ROUTES!**

This year we have created two routes. The first is a 2.5 hour drive time (not including breaks) and the second, extends the route for another half hour.

The longer route is designed for those who want to go a bit faster.

You'll leave 10 minutes before the short route participants.

These routes were designed by Robert Orcutt.

## **LEG 1: THOMAS FOGARTY LOOP**

The shorter route will turn left on Pescadero Creek Road, the longer route will continue down Hwy 84 to the coast. This way both groups will cross one another as we complete the loop!

### **SHORT ROUTE:**

Turn Right CA-35 N from Thomas Fogarty to Alice's Restaurant (4.5 miles)

Turn Left at Alice's Restaurant onto CA-84 La Honda Road (6.7 miles)

Turn Left at Pescadero Creek Road (1.1 miles)

Slight Right to stay on Pescadero Creek Road (13.8 miles)

Turn Right onto Hwy 1 N (4.6 miles)

Turn Right onto CA-84 E - Redwood City (15.0 miles)

Turn Right back onto CA-35 S Skyline Blvd at Alice's Restaurant (4.5 miles)

Turn Left into Thomas Fogarty Winery (Regroup and bathroom break)

#### LONG ROUTE:

Turn Right CA-35 N from Thomas Fogarty to Alice's Restaurant (4.5 miles)

Turn Left at Alice's Restaurant onto CA-84 La Honda Road (15 miles)

Turn Left onto Hwy 1 S (4.6 miles)

Turn Left at Pescadero Creek Road (13.8 miles)

Slight Left to stay on Pescadero Creek Road (1.1 miles)

Turn Right on yield onto CA-84 E - Redwood City (6.7 miles)

Turn Right back onto CA-35 S Skyline Blvd at Alice's Restaurant (4.5 miles)

Turn Left into Thomas Fogarty Winery (Regroup and bathroom break)

NOTE: This is the only official stop, please leave with your correct group

Thanks to Robert Orcutt for suggesting reversing the loops of the two routes.

This way we will cross each other along the way. Remember to flash your lights, honk your horns and passengers take pictures as you cross each other!

## **LEG 2: CROSS HWY 17 TO SUMMIT ROAD**

#### **EVERYONE:**

Turn Left from Thomas Fogarty on Skyline Blvd South (9 miles)

**Turn Right** onto CA-9 South - Boulder Creek/Santa Cruz (6.1 miles)

Turn Left at stop sign staying on CA-9

NOTE: Sign will say Boulder Creek (7.5 miles)

Turn Left at Bear Creek Road (12.9 miles)

As you come into the town of Boulder Creek, keep a sharp eye out for Bear Creek Road, it's easy to miss. If you see a bear sculpture and a sign saying "Welcome to San Lorenzo Valley" you've gone to far.

**Cross Over Hwy 17 and Turn Right** onto Old Santa Cruz Highway (4.4 miles) **Slight Right** stay on Old Santa Cruz Highway (1.3 miles)

**Stop** at Summit Creek Road. Sign says right for HWY 17, left for Santa Cruz

### **LEG 3: SUMMIT ROAD TO CANEPA**

#### **SHORT ROUTE:**

Turn Right on Summit Road (1.1 miles)

Turn Right to cross bridge and head to HWY 17 S (500 feet)

Slight Left to enter HWY 17 S (7 miles)

Exit 5 - Granite Creek Road / Scotts Valley Drive (1000 feet)

First Left on Scotts Valley Drive (.8 mile)

LEG 3: SUMMIT ROAD TO CANEPA

### **LONG ROUTE:**

Turn Left on Summit Road (2.7 miles)

Turn Right on Soquel San Jose Road, turns into Porter Street (11 miles)

Turn Right onto CA-1 N (2.4 miles)

Exit 440 Morrissey Blvd (700 feet)

Bend to the Right off freeway exit

Turn Left on Rooney Street (.4 mile)

Turn Left on Goss Ave (1000 feet)

Turn Right on Branciforte Drive (2.3 miles)

Turn Left on Granite Creek Road (3.2 miles)

Turn Left to stay on Granite Creek Road overpass across HWY 17 (1200 feet)

Turn Left on Scotts Valley Drive (.8 mile)
